Company had set up a Dispensary at factory location at Chennai (registered office of the Company) in the year 2021. It is operational since then and beneficiaries are village people and people residing around nearby area. Company as its CSR initiative for FY 2025-26, will contribute Rs. 3,50,000/- (Rupees Three Lakh Fifty Thousand) in total, for meeting out the cost of medical consumables, expenses of doctor and support staff, as compensation to run the dispensary.

Dispensary aims at providing the basic medicines for upkeeping the health of marginalized section of society in village area. Dispensary will target to provide/distribute basic medicines free of cost/subsidized rates to raise the standard of life of the people in and around the village area in Chennai near the registered office of the Company. Doctor and support staff entrusted to advise patients for maintaining scientific temper and will create awareness among people in and around the village area.
